




Why did you enter your local tourism awards competition in 2022? – top 5 reasons



How the competition works

Ours is 1 of 16 competitions across England aligned to VisitEngland's Awards for Excellence (VEAE)

ALL aligned competitions sign a collaboration agreement to ensure they are run in the same way

Provides a robust, fair and consistent process for applicants to compete regionally and nationally

All competitions ask the same questions and use the same scoring matrix

There are Core Categories which every aligned competition MUST run

VisitEngland provide the online Application Portal (Openwater) configured for each competition

Successful local / regional entries 'Roll Up' to VEAE – No need to apply again for nationals!

How the competition works

Any Tourism and hospitality business in Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent can apply

BUT check the ELIGIBILTY criteria carefully and read the competition terms & conditions https://www.enjoystaffordshire.com/trade/what-we-do/tourism-awards/tourism-and-good-food-awards-terms-and-conditions

It's FREE to enter and you can enter more than one category provided you're eligible

Submit a written application online, before the deadline

There are 2 rounds of judging – R1 written entries are read and scored. Highest scoring entries progress to R2, which includes 'mystery guest' judging visits https://www.enjoystaffordshire.com/trade/what-we-do/tourism-awards/judging







Applications are made online via the Openwater application portal

- Click My Account tab
- Login or create new account
- Choose category to enter
- Input data & save as you go
- No need to complete entry in one go
- Submit application when you're ready – Before deadline!

Rising Star Award

Celebrates and recognises the achievements of those at the beginning of their career in the tourism and hospitality sector – shines a spotlight on their success and champions the organisations that do the most to develop young talent in the industry.

The award recognises an individual, aged 25 and under, working / apprentice in a tourism business or undertaking vocational training who excels in their role / training and deserves to be recognised for their development, progression and commitment to the industry.

Team of the Year

Recognises a group of people working together for the same tourism business who collaborative effectively to provide outstanding customer experiences and deliver excellence across their business.

B&B and Guest House of the Year

Recognises bed & breakfast and guest house businesses that provide a fabulous service and create great memories for their guests. DOCX, 50.8KB

Small Hotel of the Year

Recognises small to medium serviced accommodation businesses that offer a fantastic welcome, memorable guest experiences and the highest standards. DOCX, 49.7KB

Large Hotel of the Year

Recognises large full-service hotels that provide exemplary service, a topquality food offering and a stay that guests will remember for years.

Camping Glamping and Holiday Park of the Year

Recognises holiday parks, sites and villages that provide exceptional guest experiences across static vans, touring pitches, shepherd's huts and more. DOCX, 44.3KB

Self Catering Accommodation of the Year

- Read the guidance
- Choose categories
- Read through the questions
- Join one of our free online application workshops
- Watch our webinar recording

Top tips 2

- Refer to the relevant criteria
- Make sure you answer the question
- Tailor your answer
- Use facts do not make ambiguous or inaccurate claims
- Support answers with evidence
- Don't assume the judges know your business!
- Use the word limit and give detailed answers
- Make every word count don't waste word count with duplication
- Ensure all aspects of your business are covered





Top tips 3

- Highlight why you are different and what are your best qualities
- Don't over complicate
- Reflect your passion and personality
- Fully answer question, use prompts to help
- Include initiatives from across the business
- Show how you act on feedback (and mistakes!)
- Don't forget accessibility and sustainability
- Embrace review sites; they can be invaluable
- Read through the form TWICE!
- Review and submit on time


