








What do Levels Represent? – Excluding Skills and Craft Delivery


























Level 3 Study Programme Pathways at 16-19























Main education and training options post-16

ACADEMIC

A Levels

Subject-based qualifications delivered over **2 years** by school sixth-forms, sixth-form Colleges and FE Colleges

TECHNICAL

T-Levels

Classroom-based programmes delivered over **2 years** by an FE provider

(80% in provider and 20% on-the-job)

Apprenticeships

Work-based training for a minimum of **12** months

(80% on-the-job and 20% classroom learning)

VOCATIONAL/APPLIED ROUTE

Vocational

Vocational qualifications typically delivered over **2 years** by sixth-form Colleges and FE Colleges (assessed via a combination of coursework and exams – includes a minimum **24hrs** work experience each year)















How does the T Level work?

T Level programme

1800 hours over two years (with flexibility)
Subject content is set by T Level panels and approved/managed by the Institute for Apprenticeships

Technical Qualification (TQ)

Between 900-1400 hours

Core

20% - 50% of the total TQ time

- Knowledge and understanding of the concepts, theories and principles relevant to the T Level and the broader route
- · Core skills relevant to the T Level
- Assessed through an external examination and a substantial, employer-set project*

Occupational specialisms (min. 1 per TQ)

50% - 80% of the total TQ time

- Knowledge, skills and behaviours required to achieve threshold competence in an occupational specialism
- Maths, English and digital skills integrated where they are necessary to achieve threshold competence
- Assessed synoptically through rigorous practical assignments*.

T Level Industry Placement

Between 315-420 hours

- Undertaken with an external employer
- Minimum of 45 days
- Students develop technical skills and apply their knowledge in a workplace environment
- Provider should pay for/contribute to travel and subsistence costs, if not covered by the employer
- Employers not expected to pay students

Maths and English requirements

- Students are expected to achieve a level 2 in maths and English. This can be achieved through GCSEs (grade 4 and above) or level 2 Functional Skills (pass)
- T Level panels are free to set higher maths and English requirements, where necessary

Other requirements set by T Level panels

 Occupation-specific requirements included, where possible, if they are essential for skilled employment e.g. licence to practice qualification or professional registration

Employability, enrichment and pastoral requirements










Differences between T-Levels & Apprenticeships


















T-Levels in Action























Upskilling or Retraining Adult Staff

Higher Technical Qualifications



Can map to Level 4 or higher apprenticeship frameworks

Adult Part Time



Various levels and topics. Varied from in person to online flexible learning, some of which can be accessed for free dependent on individual circumstances

APPRENTICESHIPS



Work based training for a minimum of 12 months (80% on the job; 20% off the job). Studied at L2, L3 and L4/5.

Higher Education



Full and Part Time HNC and HND opportunities

Community Learning



Free to access courses fully funded to support community needs and that capture spirit community

Multiply



Free to access to upskill staff members numeracy skills & confidence


